



ADHD PARENT POLICY

Policy on Refills and Follow-up visits

- Stimulants are controlled substances, therefore refills **cannot** be called into the pharmacy. Please request refill on patient portal *a few days before* your child's prescriptions runs out.

Your doctor will write a new prescription which you will need to pick up in the office.

- Follow-up appointments are mandatory to monitor for maximum effectiveness and possible side effects.
 - a. A mandatory follow-up visits within 30 days of starting medication.
 - b. Mandatory regular follow-up appointments every 3 months are required.

Prescription refills will not be given if more than 90 days had elapsed since the *last in office visit*.
